#### MISSOULA CHILDREN'S THEATRE

The Missoula Children's Theatre Company returns to the Strand on June 19-24 offering a FREE acting workshop for children who have completed Kindergarten-age 18 and seniors! **New this year**, the intergenerational program *King Arthur's Quest*, will include actors age 55 and up. During the week, participants will be immersed in many aspects related to the production of a live stage show, culminating



with two public performances. Those interested will pre-register online beginning on May 8 at <u>www.strandtheatrewv.com/events</u>. If spots are still available, on-site registration will also be open prior to auditions.

Pre-registrants/on-site registrants will audition Monday, June 19 from 10am to 12pm. All participants will audition. No advance preparation is necessary. Those auditioning should arrive at 9:30am and plan to stay until 12pm. Some of the cast members will be asked to stay for a rehearsal immediately following the audition.

The Missoula Children's Theatre touring productions are complete with costumes, scenery, props and makeup. The MCT Tour Actor/Directors will conduct rehearsals throughout the week from 10am-2:15pm each day.

There is no cost to participate, but several additional enrichment workshops will be offered after daily rehearsals conclude. These workshops will immerse participants in more specific theatrical skills for a nominal fee.

Two public performances of *King Arthur's Quest* will be presented on Saturday, June 24 at the Strand Theatre.

#### **BLUEGRASS AND POP COME TO THE STRAND**

Join us May 19 for an evening of bluegrass music and popular tunes at the Strand. This special show includes nationally recognized Crandall Creek bluegrass band and regional favorite Eli and the Mojo Kings. The night begins with special guest Bruce Winges. Backed by Crandall Creek, he will share original songs from his Eastern Kentucky album.

Moundsville based Crandall Creek will take the stage next, playing original music that respects the best traditions of bluegrass. Crandall Creek's recent release "Refrigerator Homemade Picture Show" debuted at No. 11 on the Bluegrass Today Top 20 Weekly Chart. The song, written by Jerry Andrews and Kathy Wigman Lesnock, features Shannon Slaughter on lead vocal. In 2022. Crandall Creek's single "Molly Burns" debuted at No. 7 on the Bluegrass Today Top 20 Weekly Chart. The accompanying video debuted at No. 1 on the Bluegrass Standard Video Chart, and to date has over 500 thousand views.

Popular Wheeling act Eli and the Mojo Kings will top off the evening. The Mojo Kings is a power-packed band that covers a variety of genres including rock & roll, R&B, pop and top 40. They perform music by legendary groups and artists such as Bruno Mars, Earth Wind & Fire, Justin Timberlake, Chicago, Stevie Wonder, Whitney Houston, Paul Simon and more. The Mojo Kings are led by Eli Lambie, a music teacher at Washington Lands Elementary School in Marshall County. Lambie was recently awarded the 2023 West Virginia General Music Teacher of the Year by the West Virginia Society of General Music, an affiliate of the West Virginia Music Educators Association, This show is being produced by Crandall Creek and Bruce Winges. Please support these local musicians by coming out to the show on Friday, May 19 at 7pm. Admission is \$10 for adults, \$5 for children ages 5-12, and free for those under 5 years old. Tickets will be available at the door.

#### 9 TO 5 MUSICAL AUDITIONS

The Strand Theatre announces auditions for its summer musical, 9 to 5.

*9 to 5*, with music and lyrics by Dolly Parton and book by Patricia Resnick, is based on the seminal 1980 hit movie. Set in the late 1970s. This hilarious story of friendship and revenge in the Rolodex era is outrageous, thought-provoking and even a little romantic.

Pushed to the boiling point, three female coworkers concoct a plan to get even with the sexist, egotistical, lying, hypocritical bigot they call their boss. In a hilarious turn of events, Violet, Judy and Doralee live out their wildest fantasy – giving their boss the boot! While Hart remains "otherwise engaged," the women give their workplace a dream makeover, taking control of the company that had always kept them down. Hey, a girl can scheme, can't she?

*9 to 5* will run July 28 and 29 at 7pm and July 30 at 2pm. Shelby Garrett will direct the show, Justin Jones will serve as music director, Anna Harsh will choreograph, and Meta Lasch will serve as technical director. Auditions are Monday, May 29, and Tuesday, May 30, at 6pm at the Strand. You only need to attend one night of auditions. Please prepare 16-32 bars of a song from either a musical or an upbeat pop song. An accompanist will be provided. Auditions will also consist of cold reads from the script as well a dance combo, so wear comfortable shoes you can move in. If necessary, callbacks will take place on Wednesday, May 31, at 6pm. Audition ages are high school students through adults. Auditionees are encouraged to listen to the original cast recording for inspiration.

Rehearsals will begin the week of June 12, and run Monday-Thursday evenings for approximately two to three hours per rehearsal. #### 9 TO 5 MUSICAL SPONSORSHIPS

The Strand is excited to bring live theater once again to the Moundsville community with the musical 9 to 5. Auditions will be held in early summer and the following weeks are dedicated to rehearsing and preparing the show. Producing a musical is an expensive! To perform a LIVE musical, licensing rights must be obtained. The rights for 9 to 5 cost \$2,385.

Much of the work for a theater production is done behind the scenes. The summer musical artistic team consists of

seven individuals who specialize in directing, music, choreography, sound design, light design, set design, and carpentry.

The cost for the artistic team is \$7,550. The Strand is proud to present musicals with LIVE music. Professional musicians from the

region are hired to enhance the musical experience for the audience and onstage actors. The cost for musicians is \$4,625. Costumes and set materials cost \$1,600.

Promotional materials and programs cost \$1,000. The total cost to produce the 2023 summer musical, *9 to 5*, is \$17,160.
