HOLIDAY ARTS & CRAFTS CLASSES

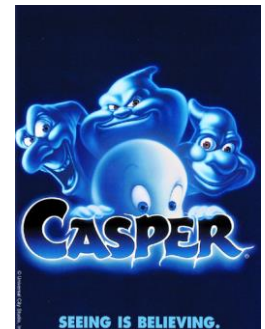
