**GOVERNOR JUSTICE AWARDS ARTS GRANTS**



Governor Justice joined West Virginia Department of Arts, Culture, and History Curator Randall Reid-Smith to present 25 grants to artists/ organizations at the Grave Creek Mound Archeological Complex in Moundsville totaling \$738,969. The Strand combined state funds received from one grant with monetary donations from the Neikamp Foundation to bring stage rigging up to today’s safety standards and a second grant to offset costs associated with the summer musical.
